Youth & Education Brainstorm

- K-12 Educational field trips & mentors
- Support local service provider community
 - How to enhance or supplement existing resources/services
- Promote local programs to campus community
 - UCB students & workers show up at local programs, learn about surrounding community
- Create a structure in which visitors of BGC can visit community organizations
- BGC act as a hub for community resources/providers as opposed to being the entity to just hold knowledge
- UCB students teaching & BGC providing internships through community partnership
- Leveraging human capital
- Create special fund for transportation for youth around city – money to expand city vans services
- Mapping of individual needs to determine collective needs of local partners
- Build/share/maintain database for West County student data
- Create fund for OST providers
 - Devote fundraising efforts for OST collaborative similar to Emeryville arts program receiving funds from local companies
- Internship program based on needs of collective
- Funding to serve local orgs that is open and with less limitations compared to existing sources
- PD/presentations to youth organizations to tie learning to career
 - Provide site for organizations to match what they're doing to what they're learning
- Mentoring program: engineering, bio science, tech, etc.
- Services to continuation schools
- Larger than the district
 - Include disengaged youth in services provided to community
