

## 2023-2024 Black History Month Arts Grant Awardees

For 40 years, since the inception of the West Contra Costa Public Education Fund in 1983, providing resources to our teachers and students in the classroom has remained a central focus of our organization. That is why we are pleased to announce that the Ed Fund has awarded \$17,900 this year in Arts grants, with support from our donors, for 18 classroom and school-wide projects, as well as community events across the district to support and commemorate Black History Month. Grants range from \$500 to \$1,500.

These projects empower teachers, students, and community members with programming that centers their voice, focuses on the needs of African-American/Black students, and utilizes the Arts as a tool to disrupt the historical inequalities within our public education system.
